FROM THE DIOCESE OF BISMARCK: We have been asked by some on the current status of (Rev.) Norman J. Dukart. His status remains the same as has been since March 20, 2002, when he was suspended from all public ministry indefinitely. The many restrictions included no public celebration of the sacraments and no wearing of the clerical dress. I strongly encourage the public to report the Chancery of the Diocese of Bismarck any suspected violations of this suspension. Those with responsibilities for minors are also reminded that the resignation and removal of the faculties were necessitated by Dukart's misconduct with minors.—Most Reverend Bishop Paul Zipfel
