STEWARDSHIP: Today we celebrate the Baptism of the Lord. The US bishops' pastoral on stewardship reminds us that Baptism gives all of His disciples a share in His priestly work and calls them "to offer up the world and all that is in it — especially themselves — to the Lord of all."

MASS INTENTIONS: Sometimes people ask about Mass intentions listed in the bulletin. By a very ancient tradition, as a way to pray for people, either living or dead, and to support priests and the Church, the faithful have requested that priests offer Masses for their intentions. Thankfully, many people request Mass intentions here at St. Joseph's Parish. Mass intentions can be scheduled by calling the Parish Office. Scheduling can be a bit tricky because we only have one priest in the parish. Single Masses will be scheduled at the soonest available date and multiple Masses in rotation. In practice, therefore, to be able to schedule Mass requests for a given date, we need to have six months or up to a year in advance notice. If a Mass has already been spoken for, we will do everything possible to have a Mass with the intentions at another similar time. We are not able to accept more masses than Father can say in a year, so if the Mass cannot be said at St. Joseph's within a year, the Diocese of Bismarck will send it to another priest (either a retired priest or chaplain, a mission priest in our diocese or another, or a priest in a parish where not many Mass intentions are offered). By tradition, a donation usually accompanies a request for a Mass. In the Diocese of Bismarck, the usual offering is \$10.00.
